

## Kroger Reward Program and Centerville Track

The Centerville High School Girls and Boys Track teams have joined together and instituted a fund-raising program with Kroger grocery stores. Kroger has many affiliated stores throughout the country. The benefits of this program will be distributed equally between both teams.

How It Works: You take a gift card from our track program organization; each card has a \$1.00 value. When you shop at a Kroger store or one of the affiliates, re-load the card with additional value. Our teams will receive a rebate check at the end of each month's cycle for 4% of the amount our donors have spent. This program costs you nothing and our athletes benefit from your shopping dollars.

It is as easy as 1,2,3!

1. Pick up your Kroger Gift Card from our track organization.
2. Reload your card with additional value the next time you shop.
  - a. You may reload your card with any amount up to \$250.
  - b. You may pay for your reloaded Gift Card with cash, check or a major credit card.
  - c. You will need to reload your card before your purchases are scanned. **This is a separate action.** Then use the card to pay for your purchases as a gift card.
  - d. The balance on the card will show at the bottom of your receipt. You may also obtain your balance at the customer service desk, cash register, by calling 866-822-6252, or at [www.gcbalance.com](http://www.gcbalance.com).
3. Every time our organization reaches \$5,000 or more in reloads our Track teams earn 4% of the total amount.
